### LITTERING ON BEACHES PROHIBITED

There has been an increase in trash left on beaches following harvests. Any person who discards or disposes of any litter or other waste material while engaged in or travelling to or from a treaty fishery is guilty of a Class B offense (17.11.41). Improperly disposing of human waste can lead to beach closures and loss of tribal income, **USE PROPER BATHROOM FACILITIES BEFORE ACCESSING THE TIDELANDS.**

### BOAT ACCESS ONLY BEACHES

Boat access only beaches are those on the schedule with a (b) after their name. Harvesters are not allowed to cross private property in order to access tidelands for commercial purposes without the consent of the property owner(s). If a monitor is unable to get to the tidelands due to bad weather, the beach is closed. Harvesting on a closed beach is a Class A offense (17.11.58).

### PRIVATE TIDELANDS

Entry on private tidelands is limited. The Private Tideland rotation list will be posted on the door of the Natural Resources Department prior to any harvest and this list will be used to select harvesters for the upcoming harvest. Harvesters on private tidelands are limited to individual quotas of 100 dozen oysters or 150 lbs. of clams. Maps will be made available in the Natural Resources Department prior to harvest.

### \*Indian Island 6\*

**Indian Island Beach 6 was seeded in 2013 and until further notice will be harvested in-common with Jamestown, Lower Elwha and Suquamish. Each tribe will get 6 harvesters and each harvester will have an individual quota of 200 lbs. The Indian Island rotation list will be used to select harvesters.**
